

Summary of H. R. Balfour File

- 7th December, 1936. Presented film of Aborigines in Kunmunya, N.W. Australia. Not to be used for commercial purposes. Film in strong room.
- 12th December, 1934. Presented set of pipes from Malekula, New Hebrides with photo.
- 22nd June, 1936. Presented 15 photographs of Wanjinjas from Pt. George IV, N.W. Australia.
- 25th October, 1937. Presented 16 Flakes from Musgrave Ranges and 4 Flakes from Ayers Rock, South Australia.
- 18th November, 1938. Presented film of the Worora Tribe.
- 15th April, 1941. Presented a Ceremonial Killing Stone from Tanna, New Hebrides.
- 21st December, 1945. Collection of 1,850 stone implements from Tasmania purchased by National Museum for £50. (Gill Collection).
- 16th August, 1946. Presented 8 prints of Cylindro-conical Stone Artefacts.
- 24th April, 1950. Presented negatives of trip to the Ceremonial Ground at Mogil Mogil.
- 12th February, 1951. Presented one Aboriginal Club from Bentinck Is. Northern Australia.
- 28th March, 1958. Presented one Bone Dagger from New Guinea.
- 10th September, 1958. Wrote stating that he would alter his Will and leave his collection of Australian Aboriginal material to National Museum under certain conditions. C. W. B. accepted condition 15th September, 1958.
- 14th February, 1962. Moule, Hamilton and Derham, Solicitors, wrote stating that Mr. H. R. Balfour, who died on 30th January, 1962, had bequeathed his collection to the National Museum in conditions specified in Will.
- 10th April, 1963. Receipt for collection signed by J. McNally and sent to Moule, Hamilton and Derham.
